

The following Standard Operating Protocols (SOPs) laid down are to be strictly adhered by all candidates appearing the BA/BSc 6th Semester Examination, 2020 :-

- (1) All candidates must reach the examination centre 1 hour ahead of the scheduled timing.
- (2) Wearing of a face mask/face shield is compulsory for all candidates, without which entry inside the College Campus would be denied.
- (3) All candidates must maintain social/physical distancing norms by keeping themselves at least 1 meter away from others.
- (4) Prior to entering the College Campus, all candidates are to be scanned with Thermal Scanner.
- (5) Before entering the examination hall all candidates must wash their hand with soap and water at the slot provided.
- (6) Mobile phone, Books, Notes and any other items that can be used for unfair means are strictly prohibited inside the examination hall.
- (7) Do not exchange pen, pencil, eraser, scale, water and any other items inside the examination hall.
- (8) All waste materials like paper, bottles etc. should be properly put inside the wastebin/dustbin
- (9) Duration of Examination is 120 minutes (i.e. 2 hours)
- (10) In case any health-related issues arise inside the examination hall, invigilators must be informed immediately
- (11) No individuals other than candidates, invigilators, Staffs, MU Officials, Security and Authorised Government Officials are allowed entry inside the College Campus.
- (12) No candidates are allowed to roam around the College Campus unnecessarily
- (13) It is advisable for all candidates to bring their own hand sanitizer
- (14) No crowding is allowed at all-time especially during entry and exit.
- (15) Candidates are not allowed to take their vehicles inside the College Campus, they may park them near the western gate (i.e. near the Principal's office) or according to their convenience.
- (16) Tobacco product such as talab, shikar etc are strictly prohibited and no spitting inside the campus or examination hall is allowed
