

Solid Waste Management Document of Churachandpur College

The College tie up with Autonomous District Council, Churachandpur for solid waste management. The Autonomous District council looks after the town of Churachandpur in terms of sanitary aspect and town planning. The College became a member of the solid waste management programme of Autonomous District Council since 2020 by paying the required amount of fee. The said district council issued consumer card to the college and the card number of the college is 204. The consumer card has the same value of agreement or MOU. Card holders are not necessarily required to enter separate written agreement/MOU. The rules and regulations are clearly written on the card. Timely collection of solid waste is done by the Autonomous District Council in accordance with their well laid down rule and regulation for further disposal in the designated dumping zone.

Attached below is the Consumer card of Autonomous District Council along with its rule and regulation of solid waste management.

RULES AND REGULATIONS TO BE FOLLOWED BY THE CONSUMER

- Every consumer should have to pay a sum USER FEE as indicated below for the various categories:
 - i) Road side vendors and petty business : Rs. 50/-
 - ii) Individual households & Small shops : Rs. 100/-
 - iii) Shops (per shutter & Rs. 100/- per additional shutter) : Rs. 200/-
 - iv) Laboratory Clinic, Workshops and Churches : Rs. 300/-
 - v) Whole-sellers, Schools, Church Administrative Office & other institutions : Rs. 500/-
 - vi) Banking and Financial Institutions, Hospitals, Nursing Homes, Colleges etc. : Rs. 1000/-
- The NGO/Office will make arrangement for provision of garbage bins/bags.
- The monthly fees should be pay through the collector authorized by the concerned NGOs/CSOs or the Office representatives on the first week of the month.
- Collection of solid waste materials will be timely. For clearance by the office Trucks, when a signal comes, the waste materials should be loaded by the respective sanitary workers engaged by the NGOs at the collection point.
- The solid waste garbage may be put into three categories viz *Plastic Waste, household waste and glass bottles/cans* separately.
- Only general solid waste excluding Bio-medical waste will be collected.
- Every consumer should have a consumer card and produce as and when required for inspection.
- Loss of replacement of the card will be made available on payment of Rs. 20/-.
- A sustained and cleaned Town is our mission.
- Dumping of household garbage inside the drains & streams is **TOTALLY PROHIBITED**, and liable to be fined.


